



CCPH COVID-19 Community Outreach and Education Plan

In Chaffee County, we follow the 5 Commitments to COVID-19 Containment:

- Maintaining 6 feet of physical distance
- Wash our hands often
- Properly wear face coverings in public
- Get tested if we have symptoms
- Stay home when sick

Critical and non-critical businesses have been required to submit a safe business checklist to certify that they have read the safety requirements and will follow them. As we strive to contain COVID-19 and maintain the safest and least restrictive environment possible, our community outreach and education strategy is to work closely with local businesses so that they have the resources and supports necessary to remain open. This is part of our virus suppression and mitigation plan.

A Community Outreach Coordinator has been hired through Protect Our Neighbors grant funding to support this plan.

Businesses that are not requiring their employees or customers to follow the 5 Commitments to Containment should expect the following steps taken by CCPH in the future when demonstrating disregard:

1. Upon learning about non-compliance, CCPH will visit with the business and make at least 2 attempts at education and outreach with management.
2. If after 2 visits, the business continues to be non-compliant without a legitimate reason, a notice of violation will be issued.
3. If the above strategies are not effective, CCPH will issue 1 cease and desist letter without a fine.

4. If the above strategies are not effective, an additional cease and desist letter will be issued with a fine up to \$1000.
5. If the above strategies are not effective, an order to report to court will be issued as a last resort to protect the health of Chaffee County.

CCPH will make every effort to work with a business to avoid steps 4 and 5. However, in Chaffee County, we hold all businesses accountable and responsible to do their part in containing the spread of the virus.
